BIG IDEA

Have you ever wondered why God's promises don't seem to be working for you? Does it seem like the territory that belongs to you has been invaded? Pastor Daniel reveals how the story of Israel's victory over their enemies shows us how to take back any ground we've lost by examining our hearts, pouring out our lives, and living expectantly.

- What would it look like for you to return to God with your whole heart?
- What is the sacrifice God is calling you to pour out? What represents radical obedience for you?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- What promises of God do you need to make real in your life by faith and practice? Search for some promises of God on the internet and choose some for this season of your life. Read the words before and after so you get the context of the promise and any instructions that precede the promise.

PRAYER FOCUS
