## BIG IDEA

## APPLICATION IDEAS

- Principles in action: 1) Go through life looking up, not around; 2) Give up something now for something I want later; and 3) Intentionally make a difference.

## PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.
