BIG IDEA

Generosity is a way of life that makes believers identifiable. Generosity takes intentionality. Join us as we learn from Pastor Daniel about the kingdom perspectives that make generosity a lifestyle.

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- Why should we seek to broaden our perspective (how we usually view things)? What are some ways we can broaden our perspective?
- According to Proverbs 11:25, what does it mean to be a generous person? What are the benefits of being generous?
- Who is God calling you to partner with during this season? Why is it important to have the perspective of partnership while being generous?
- How can generosity be an act of worship? How does giving from the perspective of worship change your heart towards generosity? What has my heart? Does it align with my finances?
- According to Philippians 4:19, what is the relationship between generosity and thinking abundantly? How does this change our point of view about our resources?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- Encourage one another by sharing your experience of God's blessings (physical and spiritual) because of your generosity.
- How is our small group generous? What are some non-financial ways we could partner together and increase our generosity as a group?

PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

- Be in prayer about your heart towards generosity this week. Ask God to reveal to you the mindsets that stop you from being as generous as God calls us to be.

LEADER TIPS

- Be transparent about your journey through generosity (even if you are still on the journey). Many times, people are not vulnerable on the topic of generosity. This is an opportunity to lead by example.
