BIG IDEA

Have you ever wondered what makes the Church different than any other organization? Dr. Eddie Cole, the Academic Dean of Lifepoint College, explains the three ways that the Holy Spirit makes the Church more than meets the eye.

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- What's the difference between the Holy Spirit being with us and dwelling within us?
- Where is the temple for the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19)? How will you honor it?
- How is God working in you to make you more than you could be in your own strength? How can you draw on the power of the Holy Spirit to see you through your circumstances?
- What is an area that you've been trying in your own might to keep together or accomplish? How can you surrender that to God?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- Miracles happen when we serve others in the name of Jesus and in the power of the Holy Spirit. If you aren't currently serving on a Dream Team, commit or recommit to doing your part on a Dream Team this week.

PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

- In the sermon, Dr. Cole referred to an analogy of the sculpture of David. He quoted the sculptor, Michelangelo, who said that he simply removed everything that didn't look like David. God wants to do the same thing for us. Be intentional this week about praying to yield to the chiseling that God is doing in your life to make you look more like Jesus.
