## BIG IDEA

Do you often ask, “what for?” when considered the meaning and the message behind Psalm Sunday and Easter? Jesus’ sole mission was and is to find lost things. As Pastor Daniel reminds us, found people find people. When we fully realize that it was Jesus who found us, we will run to find others, bring them into the presence of Jesus, and trust Him to do the rest. This is one of the purest expressions of love.

## TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- What are some examples of when you were invited to an event/experience that was important to the person inviting you? How did you feel?
- When did Jesus find you? Where were you when Jesus came looking for you? What was your response?
- Living God’s way is the best way to live. How can we convince others of this? Is it our responsibility to convince them? Why or why not?

## APPLICATION IDEAS

- If God invited us, we should bring others, and trust Him to do the rest. Be prepared to share the message, invite others to hear it, and trust God to do the rest.

## PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

- Over the next week, pray that God will reveal to you who is close to you but far from God. Share with them what Easter means to you and celebrate the newness of being found by God.

## LEADER TIPS

- Invite two or three people to church with you on Easter Sunday. If they aren’t comfortable with attending in person yet, invite them to a Zoom church service by sending a link. You can still share in the Good News together.
