### BIG IDEA

Acting on our own desires is our attempt to add to the value of what Jesus has already done on our behalf. But salvation equals Jesus plus nothing. Pastor Daniel reminds us our best efforts have no value in earning salvation. Jesus gives us the right power that we need on our journey of faith as we gratefully surrender to the Spirit.

### TALK IT OVER

- We are made of the Body, Soul (mind, will, emotions), and Spirit. What can happen when we allow our mind, will, and emotions to compete with the Spirit?
- Describe a time when someone did something to show you were loved at a moment when you really needed it. What are some ways we can do the same for people around us?
- How can you make more room in your life for God to speak to you?

### APPLICATION IDEAS

To live the good life, we must learn to surrender, listen, and obey. Practice living the good life by intentionally surrendering internal and external conflicts to God. Listen and obey the Spirit's instructions.

### PRAYER FOCUS
