## BIG IDEA

Pastor Aaron Burke, Lead Pastor, Radiant Church, Tampa reminds us that sin will take us farther than we want to go, keep us longer than we want to stay, and will cost us more than we want to pay. Through it all, God is waiting for us—with love and compassion—to come home. To get help we must return home. Not to collect resources from God, but to build a relationship with Him. Even when we are far from God, He is remarkably close.

## TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- What was home like when you were a child?
- Describe a time when you pursued the resources of God instead of a relationship with God. What was the result?
- How does God accept people who come back to Him? How do we accept those same people? Why?

## APPLICATION IDEAS

- Until you see the end, you won't remember the beginning. When you come to the crossroads of a decision, apply this message to help you remember the *Acharit* (the consequence) of those decisions.

## PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

- Pray that God will remind you of the consequences of your decisions before you make choices that don't align with God's word.

## LEADER TIPS

- Ask God how your group can serve your community to remind people who are far from God to know what it means to have a home where you are never rejected. It is not only time to come home; it is time to serve.
