BIG IDEA

A life giver overflows with generosity from start to finish. Dr. Eddie Cole, Lifepoint Senior Director of Ministries, explains that to be generous to the finish we need to embrace our true identity, commit to the Lord wholeheartedly, set our expectations wisely, and make God's glory our legacy.

- What are the characteristics and behaviors of a person who commits to the Lord wholeheartedly? How does that list compare to your level of commitment to the Lord?
- What keeps you motivated? How can you apply that to your walk with God?
- What do you want your legacy to be? What are you doing to ensure that it happens?

APPLICATION IDEAS

What next steps can you take to make sure that God's glory will be your legacy?
