## BIG IDEA

## TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- Describe an experience that you couldn't wait to tell others about. Why were you excited to share about it?
- What was the message Jesus sent by riding into Jerusalem on a donkey in Matthew 21:1-9?
- How is God calling you to be a humble carrier of the message? What are some ways we can describe who the Savior is to someone who is lost?
- What are some reasons Christians might use to delay sharing their story with others who are far from God? How can we develop a sense of urgency and pursue opportunities now?
- What instruction have you received from Jesus that you need to obey today? Where will you start?

## APPLICATION IDEAS

- Starting this week, commit to moving past good intentions to carry the message to those close to you who are far from God.
- Identify three people who may be far from God that you can invest in this week by inviting them to Easter Sunday.

## PRAYER FOCUS
