BIG IDEA

Pastor Jabin Chavez, of City Light Church in Las Vegas, reminds us that God not only saves us – He calls us. The Lord instructs people in the Old Testament and the New Testament (Genesis 12:1, Matthew 4:19) to leave and to go into unknown territory. God still speaks to us today asking us to move through the insecurities, the fears, and the unfamiliar to live our one life trusting in Him because in the absence of clarity, faith is required.
