BIG IDEA

Do you ever feel like you are constantly pushing towards something and that there's some force pushing back on you? An atmosphere of dishonor disrupts the supernatural; honor releases an atmosphere of the supernatural. Pastor Daniel explains how dislodging dishonor removes the wedge between what we desire and the reality we see in life.

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- What does it mean to value someone or something? How do you show value?
- In what ways do we risk treating God as common? How does that affect our treatment of others?
- God says to honor everyone in 1 Peter 2:17. Why does God require this from us as believers? How do we do this even for people who seem unlikeable?
- What is the difference between seeing a person's humanity rather than their identity?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- Who do you treat as common or ordinary that you need to treat with honor? What can you do to honor that person this week?
