BIG IDEA

Social media knows how to influence us in a certain way. If we're not careful, our thoughts about God can be influenced by social media rather than by the Truth. Pastor Daniel explains how to determine if we are being influenced by the Truth and sharing the Truth with others.

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- Pastor Daniel said theology is our thoughts about God. Where are some of the places people get their theology?
- What are your thoughts about God? Why are they important?
- What is truth and where do you find it?
- How do we mature and become more like Jesus?
- What shapes your theology? Why should the Bible be our source of truth?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- Test the content and messages you are receiving and see if they line up with scripture.
- Before you post on social media, ask "Is this true?" and "Is this helpful?"

PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

- Ask God to reveal any sources of influence in your life that do not line up with scripture and need to be replaced with the Truth that is found in the Person of Jesus, sets us free, is foundational, and is revealed in the Bible, which is the Word of God.

LEADER TIPS

- Don't limit your questions to those you prepare in advance. Dig deeper by asking follow-up questions when appropriate. Encourage your group members to ask follow-up questions as well.
