BIG IDEA

Are you building a "seat taken" life or a "come and sit down" life? Unfortunately, the natural drift of our heart is toward self. But there are many people who need us to intentionally demonstrate God's kindness and generosity. Pastor Daniel uses the actions of King David to illustrate the power of living with a blessing mindset and giving hope to those who need it.

SCRIPTURES USED IN THE MESSAGE

- 2 Samuel 9:1-7
- Proverbs 11:25

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- How many times did you move around when you were a child? Describe a time when someone helped you at a new location. What impact did that action have on your life?
- What does it mean to sit at the "King's table?" Why do we want to be there? How can being comfortable at the King's table prevent others from getting there?
- What limiting beliefs do you have that keep you from living with a blessing mindset? What do you need to work on to show more kindness and generosity to be a blessing to others?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- How can you show God's kindness today?
- Who will you invite to the King's table?
