BIG IDEA

Are there silent killers lurking in your relationships? Silent killers are those things that appear small and hidden but will do major damage to your relationships over time. In this sermon, Pastor Daniel identifies some of the silent killers in relationships and how we can recognize and eliminate them.

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- Describe what silent killers are and why they are dangerous in relationships. What are some silent killers we need to be aware of?
- How can unrealistic expectations be a silent killer? What are some things people expect from others that they can only get from God?
- What is the benefit of setting and honoring healthy boundaries for yourself and your relationships? In what areas do you need to establish boundaries for yourself?
- How do secrets damage relationships? How do vulnerability and honesty play a role in eliminating this silent killer?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- What are the silent killers in your relationships that you need to address? How will you start?

PRAYER FOCUS
