BIG IDEA

- God only sees you as the version He created you to be. Will you agree with His vision? What does that agreement look like to you?

APPLICATION IDEAS

- It's not our job to judge people in need. It's our job to meet their needs. They don't need our judgment; they need our Jesus. Who do you know who lives life with their cup out? Find a way to meet a practical need for someone this week and let Jesus shine through you.

PRAYER FOCUS
