BIG IDEA

There's a little fool in all of us. Fools do what's right in their own eyes and depend on their own wisdom. Stu Hodges, Lead Pastor of Waters Edge Church, reminds us that we don't have to act like a fool anymore. When we invite God in and acknowledge Him in every area of our lives, He clears the path.
