BIG IDEA

Your steps must align with the will of God. Berchman Paul, Richmond Worship Director, shared that the way we do something creates a narrative of who we are because past performance is an indicator of future performance. It is important not just to ask ourselves where we go from here. We also must ask God and follow His order. This is a sign of humility, which attracts the favor of God.
