BIG IDEA

Palm trees are designed to weather storms. Like palm trees, we must prepare our youth for the storms ahead because their testimonies will come from surviving these storms. Pastor Daniel interviewed Lifepoint youth leaders, Aaron Judkins (Youth Director--Fredericksburg), Lexi Maynor (Next Steps—Stafford), and Dakari Rollins (Youth Director—Spotsylvania) to provide insight on the storms youth face today and the exciting potential of this next generation. The overarching message from the group was to fight for our youth and never give up.
