## BIG IDEA

When you lose your why, you will lose your way. Going back to your why every now and again is important so you don't lose your way. Pastor Daniel shared that vision creates boundaries and sets your 'yes' and your 'no.' Proverbs 29:18 reminds us that without vision, the people perish. Vision helps us to see with our hearts and heed God's instruction and vision for our lives.
