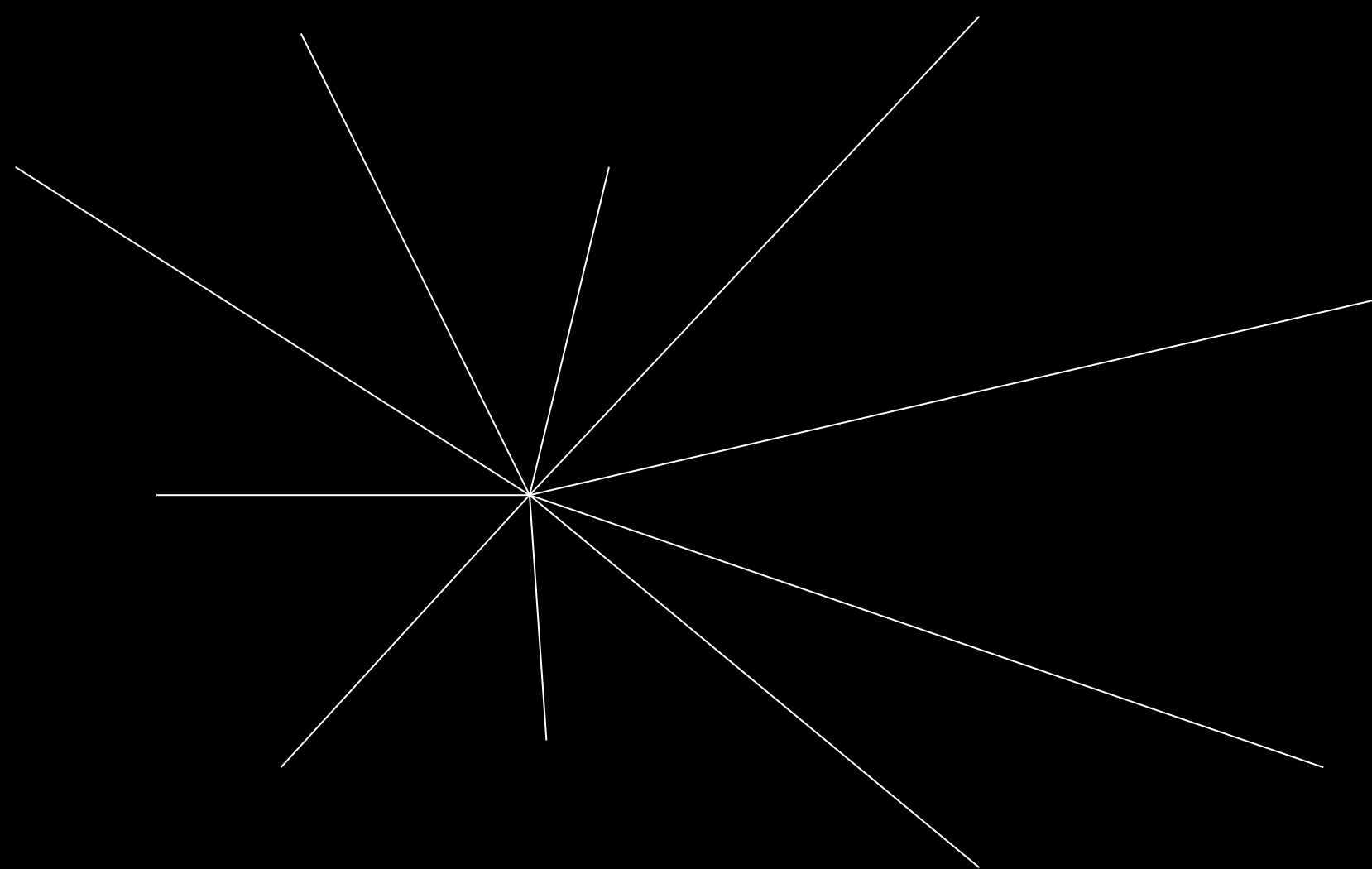

Hello, Lifepoint family!

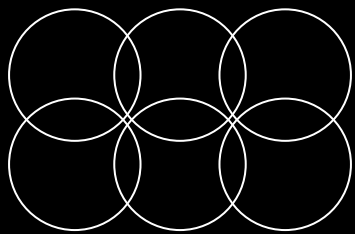

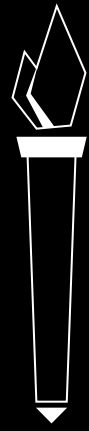

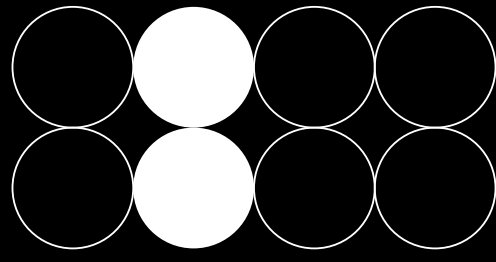
