A Filled Spirit

APPLICATION IDEAS

- If you are unsure about the call on your life, determine which of these areas you need to increase in your life and start now:
 - Obedience Right now is the right time to obey God
 - Generosity Thinking about others and how God can use our time and resources.
 - Community For humans to flourish a faith community is needed
 - Serving You're not really living the calling unless you're serving
