

MAY 25, 2025 WHEN GOD REDIRECTS Discussion Guide

SERMON SUMMARY

Jesus' is concerned and strategic about the mission of spreading the Good News to those who are lost. God is in the job of redirecting us to fulfill His mission. When God redirects, we need to be super surrendered and obedient, even when we don't know what will happen. God knows what will happen and He wants the best for us.

SCRIPTURES USED IN THE MESSAGE

• Acts 16:6-10 (NLT)

TALK IT OVER

Choose questions that keep the discussion moving. No need to discuss every question.

- Describe a time when you wanted something to happen and the opportunity was closed off to you. How did you feel?
- Why is spreading the Good News important?
- What does it mean to be super surrendered? Why is this important when God redirects us?
- How can we know when the redirection is coming from God?
- Describe a time when God redirected you. What ultimately happened through your obedience?

APPLICATION IDEAS

• What is God asking you to do? It doesn't have to be a redirect. What is holding you back from being obedient? What steps are you going to take that will move you from procrastinating to being fully obedient?

GO DEEPER

Additional ideas for a deeper study of the sermon topic.

- Pastors Daniel and Tammie shared what God has redirected them to do. What are some positive benefits that could come from the change?
- Study about God's power and omniscience. Pray that God will perform miracles due to the
 obedience of Pastors Daniel and Tammie and many others who will also be redirected in this
 season of our church.

PRAYER FOCUS

At Lifepoint, we pray until something happens. Make time in every group meeting to pray for one another and the larger matters of concern to your group.

LEADER TIPS

• Be comfortable with silence. When you ask for a response to a question, wait 15 seconds before talking. This time allows members time to think, their courage to build, and the Holy Spirit to work.
